



INSTALLATION GUIDE



- PREPARE PROPER DRAINAGE OR DRAINAGE PIPE AT INSTALLATION SITE. IT ADVISED THAT DRAINAGE LAYER IS AT LEAST 400mm (15,75")
- 2. USE HOUSING AS TEMPLATE AND DRILL HOLES FOR ANCHOR SCREWS (6MM 0.24")
- 3. FIX HOUSING ON TO SURFACE WITH ANCHOR AND SCREWS (PAY ATTENTION ON HOUSING ALIGNMENT) (SCREWS/NAILS NOT SUPPLIED BY MANUFACTURER)
- 4. INSERT CABLE CONDUIT HOSE WITH SUPPLY CABLE UP TO HOUSING
- 5. PLACE HOUSING COVER ON TOP
- 6. POUR CONCRETE OR PLACE GRAVEL/SOIL AROUND THE HOUSING
